## A Message From Rabbi Kane

Rabbi Heschel called Shabbat, the Sabbath day, a palace in time.

**He was writing** in an age when observance was popularly considered a burden. From Kosher to Services to Tzedakah. The whole idea of a Chosen People not being extra special but rather being remarkable for their willingness to be more disciplined about the desire to act in a holy manner seemed like a heaviness.

**Along** comes this brilliant American Rabbi to explain that the burden is the day-to-day obligation of work, but the Sabbath is like a visit to the Kings of old. Everything about our day of rest is different and more special. We gather together for food, prayer, to remember to cherish one another.

**I am fond** of the Rabbi's positivity, but allow me to shine his light in a different direction.

**We recently** marked the Anniversary of the destruction of the Holy Temple in Israel. What was lost?

**For Jews**, perhaps, a way to use the expertise of the Priests and Levites to relate to the Divine; giving thanks, asking forgiveness, asking for health, fertility, weather, etc

**How then** did the Rabbis wish us to communicate with the divine? How do we thank God and ask for anything?

**We build** our own palace in life. We must use the idea of being holy, of imitating as best we can, God's attributes.

When people enter our lives, shall they encounter something or someone harsh - or welcoming? Someone with no time to listen - or someone who

can make the time to hear? Someone with no interest in anyone different - or someone who can treasure our differences?

**Each way** we construct ourselves to embrace those we cherish or are willing to cherish, we build a palace in life.

**Those are** the kinds of lives that blessings embrace.
